# DON'T PUT HHW IN THE TRASH!

Take it to a convenient drop-off location in Sacramento County. It's easy and FREE!

The following items are acceptable/unacceptable at these sites:







#### ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Each customer can bring up to 15 gallons or 125 pounds per day:

- Acids
- Brake/transmission fluid and antifreeze
- Household cleaners
- Pool chemicals and poisons
- Gasoline and other flammables
- Pesticides and herbicides
- Paint (oil-based or latex) and paint thinners
- Solvents
- Household batteries
- Car batteries
- Small aerosol cans
- Home-generated needles and syringes (in sealed hard plastic or metal containers)
- Unused medications (non-controlled substances) \*not accepted at SRTS HHW
- Mercury thermometers and switches
- Used motor oil and filters
- Fluorescent tubes and bulbs
- Propane tanks (barbecue style, limit two, maximum 7 gallons)

# **UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS**

- Radioactive materials
- Railroad ties or treated wood
- Explosives (road flares are acceptable)
- Medical waste
- Asbestos
- Controlled substances
- Ammunition
- Compressed industrial das
- Polychlorinated biphenyl (PCB), a banned chemical compound previously used in coolants and plasticizers
