If you worked in 2021, you may be eligible to receive the:

- California Earned Income Tax Credit, for a refund up to \$3,160.
- Federal Earned Income Tax Credit, for a refund up to \$6,728. Eligibility depends on your income and family size

WHAT MUST I BRING TO MY TAX APPOINTMENT?

Identification

Valid government-issued ID or driver's license (no copies)

For all persons listed on the tax return:

- Birthdate(s)
- Original Social Security card(s) or Individual Tax Identification Number (ITIN) card(s) or letter(s) (no copies)

Education Credits & Adjustments

Tuition expenses for university, college or technical college (Form 1098-T)

Interest statement for student loans (Form 1098-E)

Property Taxes

Homeowner statements: verification of real estate taxes paid, or a property tax statement



Income

- W-2s for each job worked in 2021
- All 1099 forms received
- Year-end income for Social Security Insurance, workers' compensation and unemployment insurance benefits

Child Credits

- Child care expenses: provider name, address, phone number, and Tax ID or Social Security number
- **Child Tax Credit Payment** documents (Letter 6419)



Additional documents

- Copy of 2020 tax return
- Direct deposit information: voided check or routing and account number
- Health Insurance documents (Form 1095 A, B or C and 3895)

OTHER IMPORTANT REQUIREMENTS

Both spouses must be present to prepare and e-file as married filing jointly Taxpayers itemizing deductions must add up all expenses prior to having returns prepared

We do NOT provide the following services: Self-employment tax preparation Married filing separately

- with business expenses Rental Property Tax Preparation
- Out of state returns
- Military returns
